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the encyclopedia of twentieth century photography explores the vast international scope of twentieth century photography and explains that history with a wide ranging interdisciplinary manner this unique approach covers the aesthetic history of photography as an evolving art and documentary form while also

recognizing it as a developing technology and cultural force this encyclopedia presents the important developments movements photographers photographic institutions and theoretical aspects of the field along with information about equipment techniques and practical applications of photography to bring this history alive for the reader the set is illustrated in black and white throughout and each volume contains a color plate section a useful glossary of terms is also included

based on close readings of three major sitcoms this book unpacks how sitcoms understand later life sexualities and focusses on how they represent sexually active older adults focusing on three representative sitcoms *Waiting for God* *The Old Guys* and *Vicious* it demonstrates the ways in which sitcoms specifically enable and restrict representations of later life sexualities tracing how transgressive portrayals of sexually active older adults are couched in comedic terms it opens up new critical perspectives on later life sexualities that will critically inform public debates and academic research in Britain and beyond

a remarkable investigation into the hominoids of Flores Island their place on the evolutionary spectrum and whether or not they still survive while doing fieldwork on the remote Indonesian island of Flores anthropologist Gregory Forth came across people talking about half ape-like half human-like creatures that once lived in a cave on the slopes of a nearby volcano over the years he continued to record what locals had to say about these mystery hominoids while searching for ways to explain them as imaginary symbols of the wild or other cultural representations then along came *The Hobbit* in 2003 several skeletons of a small statured early human species alongside stone tools and animal remains were excavated in a cave in western Flores named *Homo floresiensis* this ancient hominin was initially believed to have lived until as recently as 12 000 years ago possibly overlapping with the appearance of *Homo sapiens* on Flores in view of this timing and the striking resemblance of *floresiensis* to the mystery creatures described by the islanders Forth began to think about the creatures as possibly reflecting a real species either now extinct but retained in cultural memory or even still surviving he began to investigate reports from the Lio region of the island where locals described ape men as still living dozens claimed to have even seen them in between ape and human we follow Forth on the trail of this mystery hominoid and the space they occupy in islanders culture as both natural creatures and as supernatural beings in a narrative filled with adventure Lio culture and language zoology and natural history Forth comes to a startling and controversial conclusion unique important and thought provoking this book will appeal to anyone interested in human evolution the survival of species including our own and how humans might relate to not quite human animals between ape and human is essential reading for all those interested in cryptozoology and it is the only firsthand investigation by a leading anthropologist into the possible survival of a primitive species of human into recent times and its coexistence with modern humans

beginning in the twelfth century clergy and laity alike started wondering with intensity about the historical and developmental details of Jesus' early life. Was the Christ child like other children whose characteristics and capabilities depended on their age? Was he sweet and tender or formidable and powerful? Not finding sufficient information in the gospels which are almost completely silent about Jesus' childhood, medieval Christians turned to centuries-old apocryphal texts for answers. In the quest for the Christ child in the later middle ages, Mary Dizon demonstrates how these apocryphal legends fostered a vibrant and creative medieval piety. Popular tales about the Christ child entertained the laity and at the same time were reviled by some members of the intellectual elite of the church. In either case, such legends so persistent left their mark on theological, devotional, and literary texts. The Cistercian abbot Aelred of Rievaulx urged his monastic readers to imitate the Christ child's development through spiritual growth. Francis of Assisi encouraged his followers to emulate the Christ child's poverty and rusticity. Thomas Aquinas, for his part, believed that apocryphal stories about the Christ child would encourage youths to be presumptuous. While Birgitta of Sweden provided pious alternatives in her many Marian revelations through close readings of such writings, Dizon explores the continued transmission and appeal of apocryphal legends throughout the middle ages and demonstrates the significant impact that the Christ child had in shaping the medieval religious imagination.

Study of late Anglo-Saxon texts and grave monuments illuminates contemporary attitudes towards dying and the dead. Pre-conquest attitudes towards the dying and the dead have major implications for every aspect of culture, society, and religion of the Anglo-Saxon period, but death-bed and funerary practices have been comparatively and unjustly neglected by historical scholarship. In her wide-ranging analysis, Dr. Thompson examines such practices in the context of confessional and penitential literature, wills, poetry, chronicles, and homilies to show that complex and ambiguous ideas about death were current at all levels of Anglo-Saxon society. Her study also takes in grave monuments showing in particular how the Anglo-Scandinavian sculpture of the ninth to the eleventh centuries may indicate not only the status but also the religious and cultural alignment of those who commissioned and made them. Victoria Thompson is lecturer in the Centre for Nordic Studies at the University of the Highlands and Islands.
